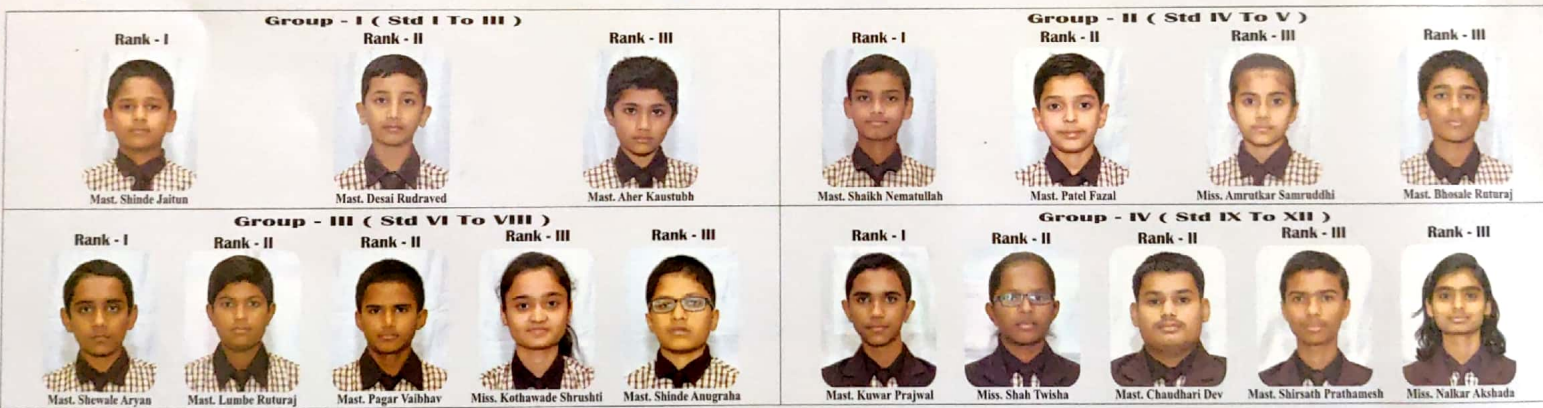
English Elocution Competition 16 Aug 2018
