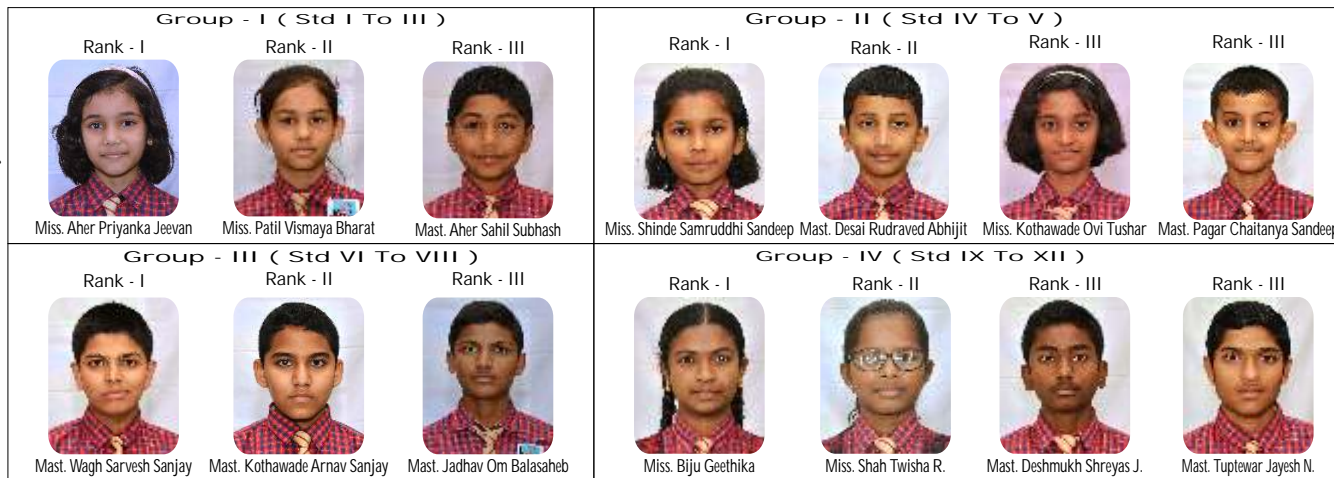

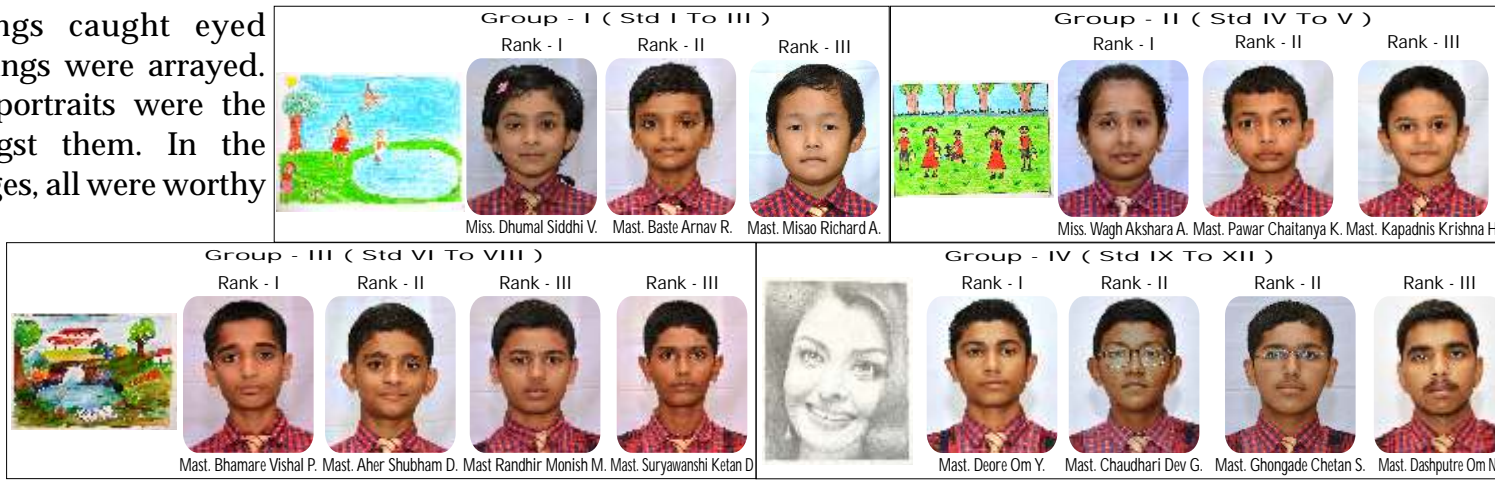
English Elocution Competition 22nd Aug 2019

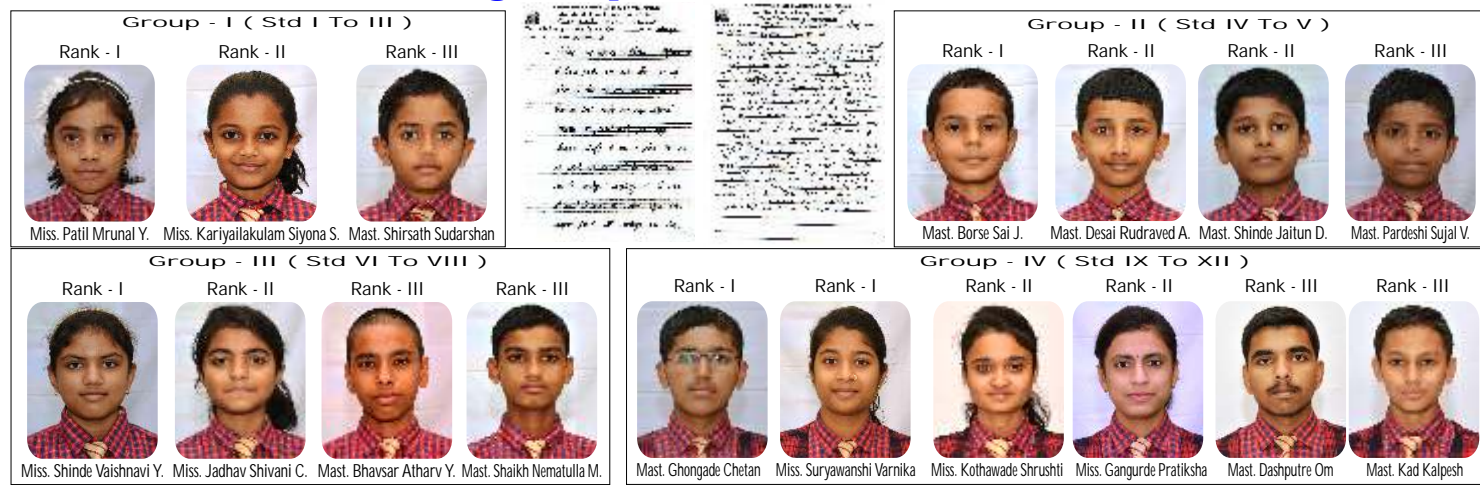
Art & Craft Competition 18th Sep 2019

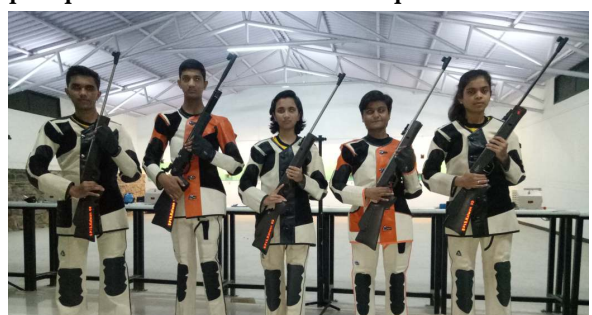


SPIS Celebrates National Sports-Day
