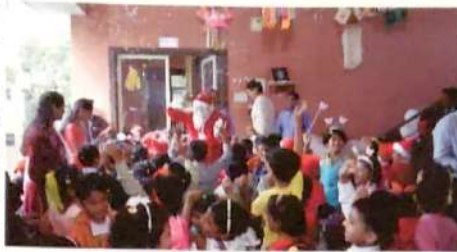


## Tiny-Tots Rock the Stage (Dance Competition)
