### SPITES UNLEASHED THE MARKING IN JEE-MAIN

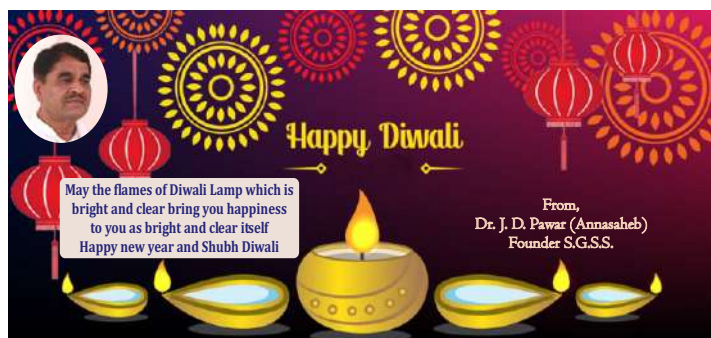


